FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I join if I have Indefinite Leave to Remain?

Yes. British naturalisation is not now required.

I am a Nepali living in the United Kingdom, can I join?

Yes, provided you have British citizenship and meet the other recruiting selection criteria.

I am now 49 years old, can I still join?

It is possible. The upper age limit is normally 43 but this rule can be over-riden if you have the skills the RLC TA requires.

What about pay?

A new TA soldier could earn over £1,800, some of it tax-free, if he completes his military training and a trade course in the first year. After completing the trade course, or after 12 months service, whichever is the sooner, pay increases by over 30%. Ex-Gurkha soldiers and officers, because they bring their military knowledge and experience earn higher rates of pay.

What rank will I get?

A new soldier starts as a Private. Those with previous service may be granted their previous rank depending on current skills and vacancies available. Officers normally retain their rank.

What trade skills can I get?

The main trade is that of Driver. However, opportunities also exist for training in the trades of Ammunition Specialist, Chef, Communications Operator, Laundry Operator, Logistic Specialist (Supply), Movement Operator, Petroleum Operator, Pioneer, Port Operator, Postal & Courier Operator, Railway Operator, Seaman and Vehicle Specialist.

Where will I join and train?

Enlistment will be at Grantham, Lincolnshire. Military skills and some trade training is done there too. Other trade training is taught at different locations. The RLC TA trains throughout the UK and overseas throughout the year.

How do I get to training?

Travel to training is free. A motor mileage allowance is paid to those who travel by car and a free ticket is provided for those travelling by train.

What about mobilisation?

If, when trained, you wish to be mobilised and serve on an operational tour, you need to volunteer. Only volunteers are currently selected for operational tours.

How do I join?

Simply ring either of the numbers shown. Application forms will be sent for your completion and return. Once document checks are complete, you will be invited to Grantham for one of the RLC's monthly enlistment weekends.
